He is sometimes called Robert Johnson II to distinguish him from an earlier Scottish composer. Johnson worked with William

Shakespeare providing music for some of his later plays. He was the son of John Johnson, who was lutenist to Elizabeth I. In 1594 Robert's father died, and in 1596 he joined the household of George Carey, 2nd B... (more online)
